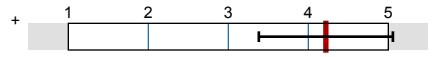

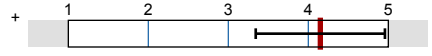

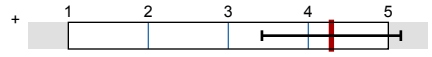

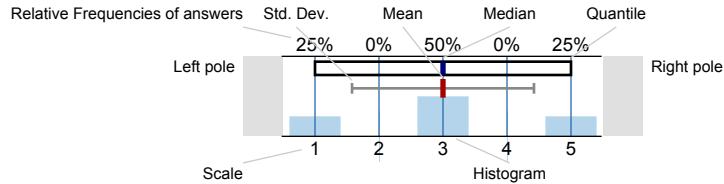

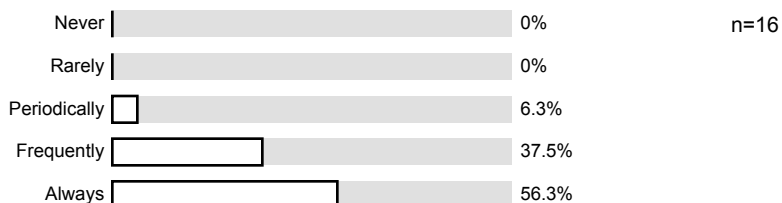

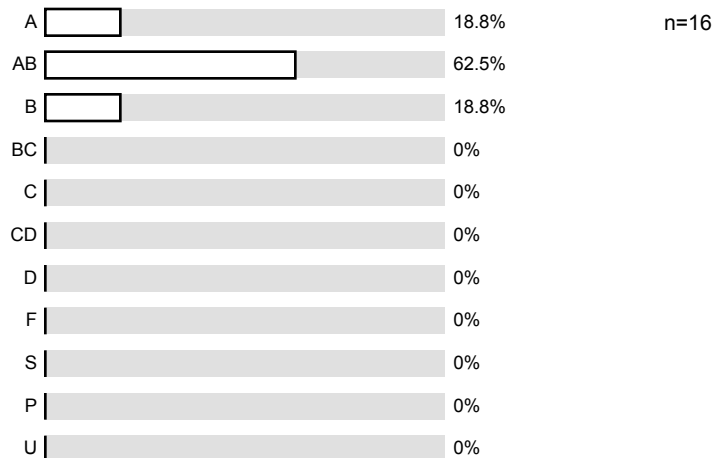
4.4) How often did you seek the professor's assistance?



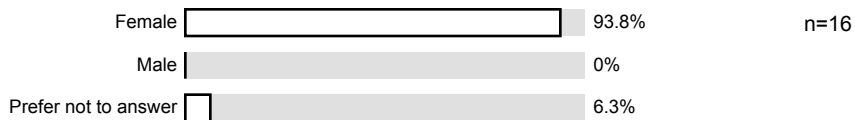

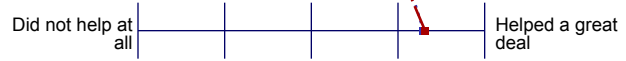
